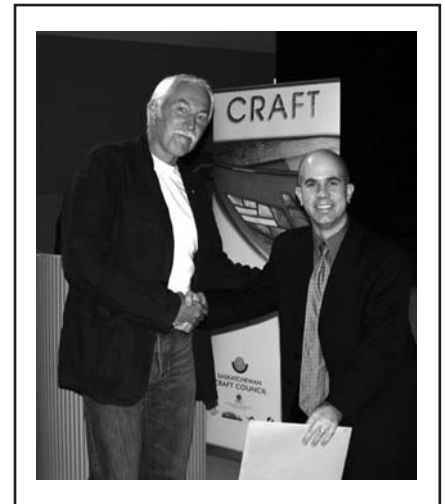

DIMENSIONS

GROWTH

- The Saskatchewan Craft Council's open, juried, touring exhibition encourages and rewards excellence in hand crafted work.
- In 2008, DIMENSIONS will include the theme of GROWTH. Interpret GROWTH literally, figuratively, spiritually, above all with creativity and innovation in Fine Craft.
- Two expert jurors will select the pieces and determine the award winners for DIMENSIONS - GROWTH.
- Pieces accepted will be on tour for approximately one year.
- The critique session by the jurors is open to all participants and interested people. An overview of the process and thoughts about the works are followed by questions and comments from the audience.

Entering DIMENSIONS - GROWTH

The procedures for submitting entries have been changed slightly in 2008.

WHO

DIMENSIONS - GROWTH is open to all Saskatchewan residents.

WHAT

- Entries will be new work of original design and exceptional execution in any craft medium interpreting the theme of GROWTH.
- Each craftsperson may enter two pieces. One entry may be a set. A collaborative work counts as one entry for each participant.
- Each entry will need a short statement (up to 50 words) about your interpretation of GROWTH.
- All entries must be ready to exhibit, with clear display instructions if required.
- Reasonable size restrictions will be in effect.
- The jurors' decision on selections from the entries is final.
- Late entries, entries arriving without previous notification, or improperly packed entries will not be accepted.

HOW

- Notify the SCC of your intention to enter works in DIMENSIONS - GROWTH by Friday, February 29, 2008. Fill out the attached form and send to the SCC Office by mail, fax, or hand delivery.
- ENTRY FORMS AND DETAILS FOR DELIVERY OF WORKS WILL BE MAILED TO PARTICIPANTS UPON RECEIPT OF THEIR INTENTION TO ENTER FORM.

WHEN

- **February 29, 2008** - Notify the SCC of your intention to enter DIMENSIONS - GROWTH.
- **April 1 and 2, 2008** - Delivery of works. Details sent after receipt of intention to enter.
- **April 3 and 4, 2008** - Jurying session for DIMENSIONS - GROWTH.
- **April 5, 2008**, DIMENSIONS - GROWTH jurors' public critique session.

ARTIST FEES

The Saskatchewan Craft Council pays artist fees at CARFAC rates for each item in the exhibition.

SALES

The Saskatchewan Craft Council will be responsible for the sale and delivery of works sold from the exhibition. We will retain a commission of 35% to cover administration and shipping.

LIABILITY

- The submission of an entry gives the Saskatchewan Craft Council the right to photograph accepted entries for publicity purposes.
- Entrants are responsible for their own transit insurance and shipping costs to and from the SCC.
- The SCC assumes responsibility for loss or damage of any entry by reimbursing 65% of the retail value from the receipt of the entry until the return date.
